**Enrollment Fee:** annual **non-refundable** fee. This fee is paid through FACTS Tuition Management.

**Tuition:** All payments are paid through FACTS Tuition Management. FACTS charges an annual set-up fee of \$25 for annual or semi-annual payment plans and \$55 for monthly payment plans. ***See additional services and fees for other costs depending on your student's interest and needs.***

- A \$250 discount will be given if full annual tuition is paid on or before August 1.
- A semi-annual payment plan is also available with a \$175 discount. Payments are due on August 1 and January 1.

**Withdrawal Fee:** If a student withdraws after the first day of class, a **withdrawal fee of \$750** will be charged. Official transcripts, report cards, and records will be released once all financial obligations have been paid. See the student handbook for additional information.

**TUITION ASSISTANCE:** After applying for all NC education assistance, families may also apply for SBCS financial assistance.

**SBCS FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE:** This assistance is for **Tuition Only**. Families must apply for assistance on an **annual basis**. SBCS has limited funds, so assistance is awarded based on FACTS income criteria. For priority consideration, families must fill out a FACTS Grant and Aid application and upload tax forms by **April 15**. FACTS requires a **\$40 non-refundable** administrative fee at the time of submission.

**Salem Baptist Church Member Discount:** This discount is available to active members of Salem Baptist Church. The discount is for **Tuition Only**.

### Three Plus Sibling Discount

**To qualify for this discount families must first apply for SBCS Financial Assistance.** This discount is available to families who enroll four or more siblings in grades K4-12. Families pay fees, lunch costs and other services for all students but only pay tuition for three students.

**ADDITIONAL SERVICES:** All fees are paid through FACTS.

**Discovery Center:** This is a program designed for students with diagnosed learning and developmental disabilities.

**These fees are in addition to the enrollment and tuition fees.**
