Homeschool Extension Classes**

Salem Baptist Christian School offers homeschool students the opportunity to enroll in classes at SBCS.

**What classes are available?**

Elementary (K5 – 5<sup>th</sup> Grade)

Core Academic Classes- \$500.00 per subject

Language Arts, Math, Social Studies, Science & Bible – Meet every day for approximately 45 minutes

Specials Classes - \$400.00 per class

Art, Computer, Sign Language, Band, Music & Performance – Meet one day per week for 40 minutes

Middle School (6<sup>th</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup> Grade)

Core Academic Classes - \$650.00 per subject

Bible, Social Studies, Grammar, Literature, Pre-Algebra, Algebra I, Earth Science & Physical Science -Meet every other day for 90 minutes

Specials Classes - \$500.00 per class

Art, Computer, Spanish, & PE – Meet every other day, 40 minutes for one semester

Chorus – Meets every other day, 40 minutes all year

Band – Meets once per week for 40 minutes all year

High School (9<sup>th</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup> Grade)

All classes meet every other day for 90 minutes - \$650.00 per class

English I, II, III, IV and AP English Literature

US History, Government & Economics, World History, Understanding the Times, AP US History

Algebra I & II, Geometry, Pre-Calculus, AP Calculus AB

Physical Science, Biology, Chemistry, Anatomy, Physics & AP Biology

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### **What are the admissions requirements?**

Students must meet all age, academic, and behavioral standards required of all SBCS students. Students must attend scheduled classes regularly and maintain academic standards and conform to the dress and conduct standards of the school. Students may enroll as late as August 31 with the first official day of school being August 14. All students pay a registration fee of \$150.00 (prior to 2/28) which increases to \$175.00 on 3/1.

### **Can my home school student participate in all school programs?**

Students may participate in Fine Arts programs and performances, including band and music.

SBCS is now a member of the North Carolina Independent Athletic Association. This association does not allow homeschool students to participate on the school's athletic teams.
