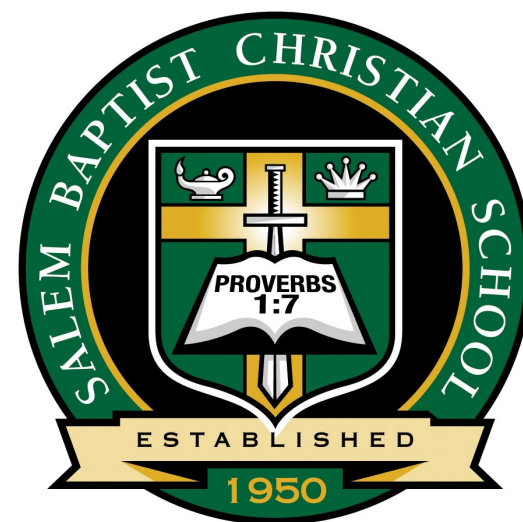


Application for the Homeschool Extension Program

Enrollment Procedure:

1. Complete the online application through FACTS at www.factsmgt.com. The school district code is SB-NC. There is a FACTS \$50 **non-refundable** application fee.
2. We will contact you regarding an interview. Please bring most recent report card and achievement test scores to your interview.
3. Once your student is accepted, you will be sent an acceptance email through FACTS, and you will need to complete an enrollment packet and submit your \$50 **non-refundable** enrollment fee.

HOMESCHOOL EXTENSION CLASSES

Middle School (Grades 6 - 8) - \$700 each

Bible, Social Studies, Grammar, Literature, Pre-Algebra, Algebra I, Earth Science, Physical Science

These classes meet two–three times a week for 90 minutes for the entire school year.

Art, Computer, PE, and Foreign Language—
\$250 per special class

Middle school art, computer, PE, and Foreign Language meet two-three times a week for 40 minutes for a semester.

Band, Choral Music—**\$500** per special class

Middle school band and chorus meets two-three times a week for 40 minutes for the entire school year.

High School (Grades 9 -12) - \$725 each

English I, English II, English III, English IV, and AP Language and Composition

US History, Government & Economics, World History, Understanding The Times

Algebra I, Geometry, Algebra II, Pre-Calculus

Physical Science, Biology, Chemistry, Anatomy

Bible Doctrine, Old Testament Survey, New Testament Survey, Church History and Apologetics

AP Psychology, Band, Chorus, Spanish I, Spanish II, ASL, AP Computer Science, Speech

These classes meet two–three times a week for 90 minutes for the entire school year.

Salem Baptist Christian School offers homeschool students the opportunity to enroll in classes at SBCS.

What classes are available?

A complete list is on the next page and includes classes for upper school students.

When/where do classes meet?

Classes meet on the campus between 8:00 AM and 3:10 PM. Middle school electives meet 2-3 times per week for 40 minutes, and high school classes meet 2-3 times per week for 90 minutes.

What are the costs for these classes?

Costs vary according to the type and level of the class. Some classes may require the purchase of a text and/or payment of a fee. All students must pay a \$50 enrollment fee.

What are the admissions requirements?

Students must meet all age, academic and behavioral standards required of other SBCS students. Students must regularly attend scheduled classes and must maintain academic standards and conform to the dress and conduct standards. Students may enroll as late as August 31 with the first official day of school being August 17. New students must complete the online application (application fee of \$50) through FACTS at www.factsmgt.com and after acceptance, complete an enrollment packet and pay the \$50 enrollment fee. Returning students complete the online re-enrollment packet and pay the \$50 enrollment fee.

Can my home school student participate in all school programs?

Students can participate in Fine Arts programs and performances, including band and music.

SBCS is now a member of the North Carolina Independent Athletic Association. This association does not allow homeschool students to participate on the school's athletic teams.
